Position Overview

VAA is now recruiting for a full-time Field Supervisor to join our team. This is a hands-on, working supervisor role responsible for leading a talented team to ensure that all airside and groundside surfaces, utilities and facilities are operated and maintained in full compliance with regulatory requirements and good industry practice. Winter season (Nov-Mar) includes standby time, after hour's callouts, shift work and varying hours of operations. This role requires a positive, 'can-do' individual who leads by example and demonstrates strong leadership skills to support and promote excellence within the department.

This is a union position reporting to the Director, Airside Operations and Safety, and will normally work a 40 hour work week during regular business hours.

Education & Experience

Post-secondary training in a related field and three year's related experience or Grade 12 with a minimum of eight year's related experience. Current Pesticide Applicator Certificate, Firearms Certification (FAC), WHMIS Certification and BC Class 3 Driver's licence with air brakes endorsement is required. Applicants with an equivalent combination of education and experience may be considered. In depth knowledge of building maintenance, mobile equipment and airside/groundside maintenance is required, along with excellent knowledge of relevant Transport Canada regulations (CARs), policies, standards and practices, VAA Airport Operations, winter operations, Safety Management Systems and safe working practices and regulations. Exceptional communications skills, both written and verbal are required as is a strong numerical aptitude.
