

Drones

Drones are not managed under the jurisdiction of the Victoria Airport Authority. Drones are regulated by Transport Canada.

While YYJ is a no-drone zone; there may be times when drones approved by NAV Canada are flying in the vicinity of the airport.

If there is an emergency (there is imminent danger presented by the drone), call 9-1-1 first. If the drone is sighted near the airport, after calling 9-1-1 call the Airport Security Operations Centre at 250-953-7511.

To report a privacy-related offence (e.g. being recorded in your home), please contact your local police.

Drones are aircraft, anyone operating a drone is considered a pilot. When you fly your drone, you're sharing the skies with other drones and aircraft. Before you fly, understand the rules you must follow and review our safety tips.
